McComb, Mississippi Adopt-a-Street Program Guideline

- 1. To submit an application for admission into the Adopt-a-Street Program, contact the Mayor's Office (601) 684-4000.
- 2. An individual, group, and/or organization may participate in the Adopt-a -Street Program.
- 3. The individual, group and/or organization must designate a Contact/Safety Representative who will attend the safety training.
- 4. Once the application has been approved, the individual, group, and/or organization shall then enter into a signed written agreement.
- 5. Eligible street(s) will be selected by the adopting individual, group, and/or organization in cooperation with the Mayor's Office. Individuals, groups, and/or organizations may select a street to adopt but it must be approved by the Mayor's Office or instead ask the Mayor's Office to select a street for you to adopt.
- 6. Six (6) clean ups are required per year.
- 7. Adopted Streets are identified by a sign bearing the Adopt-a-Street logo and the name of the adoptee. Signs will be provided by the City of McComb free of charge.
- 8. Adopting Individuals, groups, and/or organization shall contact the Mayor's Office during working hours to receive safety vests, gloves, and litter bags.
- 9. Volunteers shall wear safety vests while picking up litter. Litter pickup shall take place during daylight hours.
- 10. No one under twelve (12) will be allowed to participate. It is recommended that those who are 12-15 have one (1) adult present for every five (5) participants.
- 11. All individuals, groups, and/or organizations must use the City's reporting form and submit it to the Mayor's Office indicating the number of bags picked up.
- 12. Failure to follow the rules will cause an individual, group and/or organization to be removed from the program. The Adopt-a Street sign will be removed.
- 13. All individual, groups and/or organizations shall abide by all City and MDOT Regulations and Guidelines at all times.
- 14. All participants will hold harmless the City of McComb City, Mississippi from any and all claims for damages by person's participating in this program.
- 15. The City prohibits the possession, consumption or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol while performing work or pick up.
- 16. All Individuals, groups, and/or organizations MUST review all CITY safety rules before participating in the program.

SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR LITTER PICK UP ON McCOMB, MS STREETS

DO's

- Do wear ANSI approved safety vests at all times.
- Do wear light colored clothing, long sleeves, a hat, gloves, sunscreen and protective work shoes or boots.
- Do face oncoming traffic and look up often to monitor approaching vehicles.
- Do park all vehicles off roadways and shoulders at least 5ft away from shoulder.
- Do work along one side of the street at a time. Do not cross back and forth across the street.
- Do stay on the grass and off the pavement when possible.
- Do be alert for snakes, insects, ticks and poison ivy/oak and other noxious weeds.
- Do work during daylight and drink water to prevent dehydration.
- Do watch your footing when walking and be cautious of holes and obstacles.
- Do have a first aid kit available at all times.
- Do report your numbers to the Mayor's Office (Public Works).

DON'Ts

- Never work on roadway, shoulders or bridges.
- Never unload work crews on shoulders or highways.
- Never participate in activities or horseplay that might distract drivers.
- Never wear audio headsets or talk on cell phones when picking up litter.
- Never pick-up, remove or touch hazardous substances like syringes or hypodermic needles.
- Never exit from a vehicle into coming traffic.
- Never remove dead animals.
- Never overfill or stuff trash bags. Remember to tie bags.
- Never participate in a litter/Trash pick up if you are not in good health; have poor eyesight; or poor hearing.
