All parade entries/participants **MUST** turn left onto Gay St off of Delaware Ave to continue to Virginia Ave before unloading.

DO NOT STOP ON GAY STREET!!!!


YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO STOP and UNLOAD until you have reached the designated "Participant Unloading Zone" at Douglas Park on Virginia Ave.

Walking Groups are to disperse into the parking lot directly past Kyoto (Japanese restaurant) toward Kroger.

DO NOT BLOCK THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC!

We urge everyone to be careful and aware of their surroundings to avoid any accidents.

PARADE BEGINNING INSTRUCTIONS:

All Parade Entries MUST enter on 21st Street to proceed to the Checkpoint.

All entries MUST meet the following requirements to pass the Checkpoint:

- Must have Issued Registration # (The exact # on the original paper given at registration) placed in the front left side of windshield, displayed by the front left side person of a walking group, or on the left side of a motorcycle.
- Must have all decorations completed.
- Must have all participants onboard.

[If you do not meet the requirements at checkpoint, an officer will direct you to exit on Thompson Street.]

Parade lineup may start at 7:30 AM.

No entries will be allowed to check in after 10:45 AM.

You MUST arrive before 10:45 AM.

We recommend that each entry have all riders/participants onboard/present at checkpoint. In the event of late arrivals, we have designated a "Late Participant Drop-Off" area at 5th & Front Street. An attendant will be available to attempt to assist in directing you towards your parade entry's location. This is to be used as a last resort. There is minimal parking available in this area designed for drop-off only.

Late Participant Drop Off will END at 9:45 AM and streets will be blocked off.

NO LATE PARADE APPLICATIONS/ENTRIES
WILL BE ACCEPTED ON DAY OF PARADE.
